LiveVoice has a direct integration with RingCentral Events (formerly Hopin). Here is how it works.

Listeners will be able to choose the language next to any video stream in [RingCentral](#).



Setup

1. Install the LiveVoice integration in RingCentral
2. Create a LiveVoice account (Sign up [here](#))
3. Create the event and audio channels (Learn how to do this [here](#))
4. Copy the listener code (See how to do this [here](#))
5. Name the RingCentral tab, for example "Translation" and insert the LiveVoice code into the code field. Done!

Synchronizing for hybrid events: If you use RingCentral for a hybrid event, you might want to synchronize the audio of the language translation for the online audience. In this case use our **delay feature**. [Learn more about the delay feature here.](#)

There will be a message displayed in the Translation Tab that says that in English, Spanish, and German. If you need other languages, you can [use the event message from LiveVoice](#) instead.
