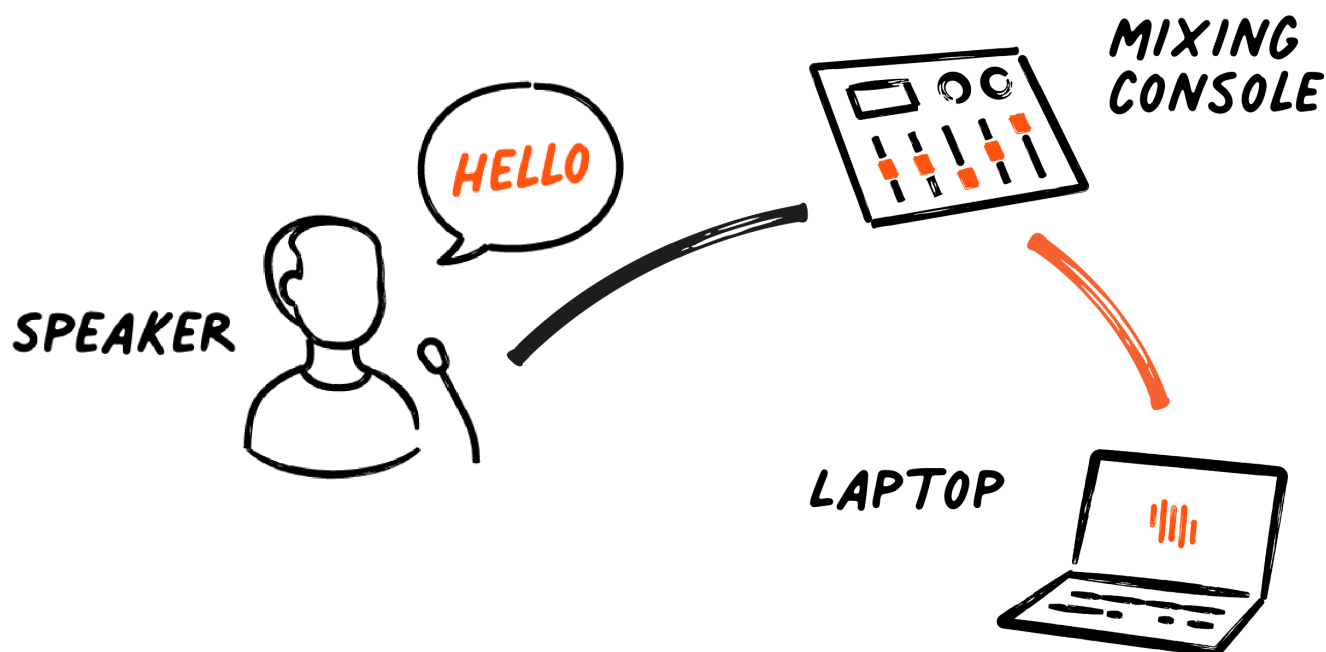


Ingesting audio to a computer with an audio interface

If you want to stream the original audio from stage, the most common way will be to get your signal from an audio mixer into your laptop or PC. You usually do this with an USB audio interface, [like this one](#).



Follow these steps:

1: Choose an Audio Interface

You can use either a Mono or Stereo interface, depending on your requirements.

2: Connect the Audio Interface

Connect the Audio interface to your computer or device using a USB cable.

3: Connect the Audio Interface with your audio mixer

Send the Main Audio Feed from your sound mixer via XLR or Jack to your interface.

4: Set the Gains

Adjust the gain levels on your Audio interface to ensure that the audio signal is not too low or too high. This will help prevent clipping and distortion.
